Ministry Project Outline

You are probably involved in a ministry. Please develop a plan of action that could improve, expand, or otherwise make more fruitful than ministry work that you either are doing or are being called to do. Consult with the Lord, with your leaders, and with other seasoned Christians. Be accountable, creative and passionate for what you plan and do. Done well, this ministry project would be fruitful and fun-benefiting others and you-and it will also be a measurable step toward even greater service for the Lord Jesus Christ.

Please note that the ministry projects should include:

1. Praying and consulting with the Lord and with your leaders and trusted friends that your ministry project, which in some ways relate to something you learn in this particular capstone curriculum model
2. Writing your ministry project proposal, preferably improving a ministry you are already doing or that you are being called to do-including prayer, witness, teaching, counseling, preaching, feeding, or other ways of caring for others-and sharing your proposal with your ministry leader and with your professor for their guidance.
3. Completing the ministry project: reviewing what you are learning-possibly recruiting others to participate and preparing some new tools(such as Flyers, Bible outlines, handouts, letters, food, activities)-and then doing serious, fruitful ministry.
4. Summarizing and evaluating your ministry project writing a brief reflection report to give to both your ministry leader and your professional, and to receive their further encouragement and guidance/
 - a. What you planned
 - b. What you did
 - c. How it went
 - d. What you learn

Outline for Ministry Project Format:

* The paper should be typed and double-spaced using a clear, non-ornamental, serif font. Examples of acceptable fonts include Times New Roman or Palatino. The text of the paper should be set in 12-point type with footnotes in 10-point.

* Margins are typically 1" on all sides.

* Page numbers should be included on all pages in a place that remains consistent throughout the paper (i.e., top right on every page, bottom center on every page, etc.).

* Only one space (not two) should be placed after the terminal punctuation of a sentence.
